Ad hoc Exemption Order No. 5/2021-Customs

New Delhi, the 31st May, 2021

G.S.R. (E)...- In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of section 25 of the Customs Act, 1962 (52 of 1962), the Central Government, under exceptional circumstances prevailing due to the COVID-19 pandemic, on being satisfied that it is necessary in the public interest so to do, hereby makes the following amendment in the ad hoc exemption order of the Government of India, in the Ministry of Finance (Department of Revenue), No. 4/2021-Customs, dated the 3rd May, 2021, published in the Gazette of India, Extraordinary, Part II, Section 3, Sub-section (i), *vide* number G.S.R. 316(E), dated the 3rd May, 2021, namely:-

In the said order, in paragraph 2, for the figures, letters and words “30th day of June, 2021”, the figures, letters and words “31st day of August 2021” shall be substituted.
