We are truly grateful for our partnership with CII that has enabled us to channel our collective expertise and resources in reaching last mile beneficiaries to nurse them back to financial or physical health.

During the past year, CLP India contributed INR 41 million towards the overall COVID-19 relief and resilience building projects. Besides supporting local non-profits and Akshaya Patra Foundation, our partnership with CII played an important role in initiating a country-wide relief operation utilizing CLP India funds.

Synopsis of CII and CLP India's partnership during the first wave of COVID-19

Through our joint COVID-19 relief efforts with CII Foundation in 2020, we were able to benefit over 90,000 individuals across India. We partnered with local organisations in business catchments to provide relief aid and hygiene kits to government offices. Our partnership also enabled us to reach out to more than 400,000 people including notified and de-notified tribes, people affected with leprosy, elderly, women and children affected by the pandemic. Most importantly, we were extremely touched by the efforts of the team of CII women exemplars and grassroot women leaders who played an important role in enabling our relief operations and building COVID-19 resilience in communities.

Our commitment to continue supporting CII during the second wave of the pandemic

We are all witnessing the second devastating wave of COVID-19 pandemic. This wave has been extremely difficult as all of us have felt its effects at a personal level. It is an extraordinary situation and it is important to reinforce the country's healthcare infrastructure for citizens' health and safety. As the second wave of COVID-19 continues to affect large parts of the country including our catchment communities, it has become imperative to enhance COVID appropriate behavior, and speed up the COVID vaccination drive to effectively fight the pandemic.

We are determined to support our country through this unprecedented health crisis and have pledged an aggregate INR 68 million to support relief efforts. From this fund, CLP India extended INR 30 million support to CII Foundation and INR 10 million to local non-profit partners. CLP Holdings is also working closely with India Consulate General office in Hong Kong and has committed HKD 3 million (~ INR 28 million) support, part of which will go to PM Cares fund and CII.

Financial assistance alone cannot help in the fight against COVID-19, therefore, our CLP India CSR team pledges to work closely with CII Foundation to help expedite the support and relief work as needed, especially towards strengthening the government's efforts in our collective fight against the pandemic. We remain committed to supporting CII with necessary medical essentials including oxygen and other medical supplies. In addition to this, we will continue to work towards encouraging participation in the ongoing vaccination drive that will help us build our collective long-term resilience.
