O R D E R S

Imphal, the 31st March, 2021

WHEREAS, the undersigned Chairperson, State Executive Committee of the State Disaster Management Authority in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 20(2)(a) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 issued Order of even number dated 02.03.2021 allowing various activities subject to strict adherence to prescribed Covid Appropriate Behaviour and Standard Operating Procedures issued by the concerned Ministries of Government of India and the additional conditions relating to gatherings.

2. WHEREAS, order No.9/6(1)/2020-H(Pt) dated 09.03.2021 was issued relating to observance of SOP during "Yaoshang Sports" and restriction on organising "Thabal Chongba" and "Jatrawalli".

3. WHEREAS, Order No.9/6(1)/2020-H(Pt) dated 15.03.2021 was issued relating to restriction in gatherings during celebration of "Lai Haraoba".

4. WHEREAS, the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India vide its order No.40-3/2020-DM-I(A) dated 23.03.2021 has issued guidelines for effective control of COVID-19 to be implemented w.e.f. 01.04.2021.

5. NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 20(2)(a) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 the undersigned in his capacity as Chairperson, State Executive Committee of the State Disaster Management Authority hereby orders that the guidelines for effective control of COVID-19 as **Annexed** herewith shall be implemented w.e.f. 01.04.2021 and shall remain in force till 30.04.2021. The following additional guidelines shall also be strictly adhered, enforced and shall remain in force till 30.04.2021:

- i. All persons who come out in public places shall wear mask without fail.
- ii. Size of the family gatherings for social, religious and customary ceremonies should be restricted to 50 (fifty) or less persons strictly.
- iii. Size of the gathering for Religious, Sports, entertainment and cultural should be restricted to 100 (hundred) or less persons strictly.
- iv. All Deputy Commissioners and District Superintendents of Police shall enforce The Manipur Epidemic Diseases (Enforcement of Covid-19 Guidelines) Regulations, 2020 strictly.
- v. Any persons violating these guidelines will be liable to be proceeded against as per the provisions of section 51 to 60 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 besides legal action u/s 188 of the IPC.
