

# GUIDANCE CHECKPOINTS FOR MANDIS - FRUITS AND VEGETABLES

MEASURES TO BE TAKEN BY STATE AUTHORITIES



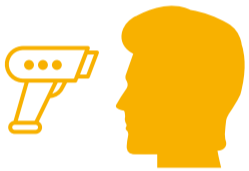
Display Do's/Don'ts Instructions on COVID 19 and provide training.



Restrict multiple entries to the Mandi.



Ensure masks, gloves, caps, uniforms for Security staff/ Volunteers at entrance, exits and for patrolling



Ensure temperature screening (not more than 99.5 Degree F) with non-contact thermometers of all staff, buyers and sellers at the entrance.



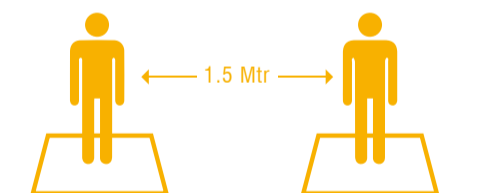
Prohibit entry of sick persons with Cough, High fever (more than 99.5 Degree F), running nose and shortness of breath



Notify competent authority of any sick persons for ensuring immediate isolation.



Establish sanitation stations with automated liquid soaps/ sanitizer dispensers/ soap and running water at the Entrance (one tap for 15-20 persons approx).



Put Paint marks for ensuring social distancing (approximately 1.5 metre) In queue



Identify separate designated Garbage areas for Wet and Dry Wastes



Clean premises, facilities, stores, toilets, garbage areas and fumigate using approved cleaning chemicals, Fumigation Agency & Operator after the Mandi closes.



Distribute Masks for Farmers, Traders and Mandi Operators.



Ensure Personal Protective gears for Garbage Handlers (Hand gloves, Masks, Uniforms, Covered Shoes)

P.S

To prevent spread of COVID-19, WHO and MOHFW recommend individuals employ social distancing or maintain approximately 1 metre (3 feet). CDC recommends approximately 2 metre (6 feet) from others, when possible. As a best practice, approximately 1.5 m could be maintained.
