ORDER: IMPLEMENTATION OF CONTAINMENT MEASURES


Whereas, in order to contain spread of COVID-19 pandemic, state government has issued an order No 753-ISS/2M-22/2020 dated 14/06/2021, under Disaster Management Act 2005 read with West Bengal Epidemic Disease, COVID-19 Regulations 2020.

However, in view of the prevailing Covid-19 pandemic situation across the state of West Bengal, it is more than advisable for all the stakeholders to remain on high alert notwithstanding the fact that the cases of infection have come down significantly over the past few weeks.

It is further suggested that strict containment measures must be introduced to prevent the further spread of the disease. Municipal Commissioner, Kolkata Municipal Corporation and District Magistrates of districts are hereby requested to ensure the following:

1. District Covid data must be analysed to find out the local hotspots and pockets of high incidence. Such hotspots across the district may be identified as containment or micro-containment zones as the case may be;
2. Strong surveillance measures must be instituted in these containment zones. Norms of physical distancing and Covid appropriate behaviour must be strictly enforced in these areas;
3. Early testing, tracing and tracking of suspected cases must be ensured for better clinical management of such cases;
4. Meetings with all the relevant stakeholders must be held on regular basis for ensuring implementation of all the measures specified above.

All concerned are requested to ensure implementation of above directions.
