

# FEDERAL BANK

Federal Bank has undertaken major COVID relief programmes in Kerala. These include provision of 100 ICU Beds at the Special COVID Block with oxygen plant, ventilators, etc at District Hospital, Aluva and setting up of First Line Treatment centres at various locations across the state. The Bank has provided protection gear to health workers, COVID testing kits to the Government hospitals and a PCR testing machine to the National Health Mission, Trivandrum. It has invested in COVID related research through IIT Palakkad. In the vaccination space, the bank has provided 10,000 vaccine carriers to the Director of Health Services, Trivandrum and three AC vans to Malappuram District for vaccination drives.

The Bank has also set up Handwash Stations and Mobile ATMs at various public places. It has supported transportation of migrant labourers from Kerala and instituted Livelihood enhancement projects for unskilled/unemployed. As in Kerala, Federal bank is providing direct support to other States as well in their COVID control initiatives. On a pan India level, the Bank has committed around INR 45 Crore for COVID relief initiatives through its CSR foundation.
