Subject: Honour of passes of other States/UTs in the State of Haryana during night curfew.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to Haryana State Disaster Management Authority (HSDMA) Order No. DMC-PO-I-2021/332 dated 12.04.2021 (copy enclosed) with regard to imposition of night curfew on movement of individuals in the State of Haryana. This order inter-alia provides exemption from the restriction of movement to certain category of individuals related to transportation of essential commodities and services on production of valid I card or E-pass.

2. Further, in order to facilitate the movement of all essential goods and services (as enumerated in aforesaid order) in the state of Haryana from other States/ UTs, it has been decided that passes issued by other State Governments /UTs in this regard, shall be permitted within the State of Haryana.

3. Therefore, all Deputy Commissioners and Police authorities in the State of Haryana are requested to honour the valid I-card or E-pass issued by other States/ Union Territories for transit within the State of Haryana. District authorities shall also sensitize the field functionaries about these instructions for strict compliance, in letter and in spirit.

4. This order shall remain in force till the imposition of night curfew on movement of individuals in the State of Haryana.

ORDER

Whereas, the country is at critical juncture in its fight against COVID-19 and the Ministry of Home Affairs, Govt as well as the Government of Haryana as issued various guidelines from time to time to prevent the spread of COVID-19. However, there has been a recent surge in numbers of COVID-19 cases and therefore, it is imperative to put in place in strict measure of isolation and social distancing to contain the spread of COVID-19 as a lot of non essential movement of people and vehicles during night has been reported.

Whereas, in exercise of powers vested under Disaster Management Act, 2005, the undersigned in my capacity as Member, Haryana State Disaster Management Authority hereby order that there shall be prohibition on movement of individuals for all non essential activities between 09:00 PM to 05:00 AM in the state of Haryana. No person shall leave their homes or shall move on foot or by vehicle or travel or stand or roam around on any road or public places during the above said hours.

However, the movement of following persons and services shall be exempt:

1. Those tasked with law and order /emergencies and municipal services/duties including Executive Magistrates, Police personnel, Military/ C.A.P.F. personnel in uniform, health, electricity, fire, media persons with accreditation and Government machinery tasked with Covid-19 related duties (All on production of Identity Card).
2. Those specially issued a restricted movement CURFEW pass by the officers authorized in this behalf.
3. There shall be no curbs on inter-state and Intra-State movement of essential and non essential goods.
4. All Vehicles/persons In bonafide transit (inter- State/intra-State) shall be allowed to pass, but only after verification of point of origin and destination.
5. Hospitals, chemist shops and A.T.M. shall be allowed to remain open 24 X 7.
6. Pregnant women and patients for getting medical/health services.
7. Passengers going to or returning from airport or railway station of I.S.B.T shall be exempted.

Strict enforcement of the orders


Any person violating these measures will be liable to be proceeded against as per the provisions of Section 51 to 60 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, besides legal action under Section 188 of the IPC, and other legal provisions as applicable.

This order shall come into force with effect from 9:00 PM to 05:00 AM on 12.04.2021 and shall remain in force till further orders.

In view of the emergent nature of the order, it is being issued ex-parte and is addressed to the public in general.

This order shall be promulgated by affixing copies thereof at the notice boards of the office of the Deputy Commissioners as well as District Courts and publication in the newspapers having circulation in the area, through the office of the DIPRO, Haryana.
