Setting up oxygen generating plants at hospitals

Installing medicare facilities and providing support staff to various hospitals

Hyundai India has announced a relief package of INR 20 crore which will be donated through its philanthropic arm, Hyundai Motor India Foundation (HMIF). As a part of the Hyundai Cares 3.0 relief initiative, the South Korean automaker has announced a series of measures to provide infrastructural assistance to affected states of Maharashtra, Delhi, Haryana, Telangana and Tamil Nadu. This includes deploying its resources to set up oxygen generating plants at hospitals, installing medicare facilities and providing support staff to various hospitals and catering to their operational cost for three months, and even further if required. It will also augment its Mobile Medical Units and Telemedicine Clinics in rural areas.
