

# JANASEVA FOUNDATION

The Foundation, which provides elderly care, health care, destitute care, care & school education of street children, education, skill development, village development etc. has been very active in providing COVID relief in and around Pune. The Foundation's Comrade Late Govindrao Dhapare Rural Hospital at Ambi Ranwadi, Block Velhe, Pune, has been taken over by the Disaster Management Authority of Government of Maharashtra and has been declared as a COVID Centre. The hospital serves more than 50 rural & remote villages having population of more than 50,000. It can accommodate 80 patients and also provides ambulance services even for very remote villages. This COVID Care Centre has allowed the villagers to avail COVID treatment within 5-10 kms from their place.

The Foundation is conducting an awareness campaign on vaccination and organizing training sessions for ANMs, Asha and Anganwadi workers and other frontline workers. Its Meals and Wheels initiative provides cooked food to the elderly at their locations. Earlier during the first lockdown, Janaseva spent around INR 1.2 crores and served about 600,000 cooked meals and distributed 15,000 kg grocery kits. It also distributed masks, sanitizers and soaps. In addition, along with Public Health Foundation of India, Janaseva distributed cooked meals to poor families, grocery kits to the HIV positive women and masks & sanitizers to the HIV positive women & primary school children, in Pune.
