

# TECHNICOLOR INDIA

Technicolor has been working with its global team to address challenges within the organization and in the community. It has partnered with Oxfam India, to provide immediate response to healthcare challenges. A fundraiser has been started for all Technicolor employees globally and to stakeholders in the industry. Technicolor has committed to match donations up to a total of EUR 100,000. The funds will be used to provide medical equipment and supplies like oxygen concentrators, oximeters, PPE kits, hospital beds and other relevant material. The funds will also be used for providing relief to the vulnerable through food, dry ration and livelihood support. Technicolor is in advanced stages of a partnership with ITPB and Capitaland for a COVID care facility. This facility, catering to mild or no symptom cases, will service the employees at the tech park at Bangalore and support staff and their immediate families, especially those who do not have home isolation facility. In terms of the safety and wellbeing of its own staff, Technicolor has accepted an additional insurance policy that addresses the needs of the current COVID urgencies. The company is also exploring a vaccination drive for its employees and their spouses.
