


TOTAL OIL INDIA PRIVATE LIMITED

Total India has been providing support to the marginalized communities, frontline workers and local authorities. It has been providing medical equipment & provisions since the onset of the pandemic. Total India is an active member of a consortium of French companies based in India, who have joined hands to provide lifesaving oxygen and other critical equipment to support India's overwhelmed medical facilities. The initiative has been coordinated under the aegis of the French embassy and Indo French Chamber of Commerce.



The first shipment has already arrived in India and assembled in hospitals and healthcare facilities in New Delhi, Mumbai & Telangana. These include -

- 8 medical oxygen generators, manufactured by a French SME, each of which can make an Indian hospital autonomous in oxygen supply for approximately 10 years. These oxygen production units can produce medical oxygen from ambient air yearlong. Each unit can uninterruptedly supply a 250-bed hospital. Its oxygen output can fulfil the needs of 15 critically ill COVID patients in an ICU (or 30 patients in the ICU of a conventional hospital) or 150 patients on oxygen therapy in a

conventional hospital facility. These oxygen generators also include ramps for filling oxygen cylinders.

- Containers of liquid medical oxygen – 5 being sent in the first installment – capable of supplying medical oxygen to up to 10,000 patients for a day.
- Specialized medical equipment, including 28 ventilators and their consumables, as well as 200 electric syringe pumps.

Further, the company is working with local authorities and NGOs, to provide critical oxygen equipment such as oxygen concentrators and ventilators, BiPaP machines and hospital beds particularly in the cities of Bengaluru and Mumbai. Three hospitals and six healthcare centers will receive equipment based on the identified needs. It has provided PPE kits to public hospitals, distributed 50,000 sanitizer bottles to front line workers and ration kits to over 400 marginalized families. The company has sensitized auto rickshaw drivers and equipped them with protective kits to have 4000 COVID ready autorickshaws soon in Bengaluru.
